About Fifth Ward Community Redevelopment Corporation (FWCRC)

Fifth Ward CRC was organized in April 1989 by 5th Ward community members, business owners, and church leaders. FWCRC strives to be a driving force for redevelopment in 5th Ward, offering its leadership and coalition building skills to improve the quality of life for its residents. FWCRC strives to make 5th Ward a Community of Choice—a better place for people to live, work and play!

FWCRC realizes its mission through Real Estate Development, Homeownership Promotion and Preservation, Arts and Cultural Development, Community Engagement and Economic Development.

About the 5th Ward neighborhood

Beginning in the early 1920s, French-speaking Catholic migrants from southwestern Louisiana began moving to 5th Ward. The enclave that became known as "Frenchtown" developed when the Southern Pacific Railroad recruited Creoles of color in 1922. By 1925, over 40 Black-owned businesses lined Lyons Avenue, the main thoroughfare. During the 1980s and 90s, the community experienced a decline due to disinvestment and a downed economy. However, today the community is enveloped in revitalization, growth, and inclusivity. The Greater 5th Ward has more than 25,000 residents, and is increasingly diverse, with the historically African American neighborhood now about half Hispanic and half African American.

The site of the city's first black settlement, many historic churches and the first black arts complex, the 5th Ward has a rich history. Its native sons and daughters include the late Congressman Mickey Leland, Congresswoman Barbara Jordan, and El Franco Lee. 5th Ward also birthed Hip-hop artist DJ Premier, the Geto Boys' Willie D, World Heavyweight Champion George Forman and music standouts, Joe Sample and the Crusaders.
